Be imaginative!</p>	<p>Write a letter to one of your favourite story characters and tell them what you enjoyed about their story. Will it be addressed to the Three Little Pigs? Marvin or Molly? Maybe the Big Bad Wolf?</p>	<p>Make a mask of one of your favourite story characters and retell the story to an adult. Remember to bring in your mask to show it to your teacher and your friends.</p>
<p>Use books or the internet to find out a fact about your favourite animal. You could draw a picture or write your fact with a grown up to share with our class.</p>	<p>Stand with your bare foot on a piece of paper and trace around it with a pen. Can you find 5 things in your house that are shorter than your foot and 5 things that are longer? Write a list of the things you find.</p>	<p>The Three Billy Goats Gruff want to cross the river to eat the green grass on the other side. Build a strong bridge for them to cross. You can choose to create this however you like.</p>
<p>The mean troll did not want to let the three Billy Goats cross the bridge. What would you tell him if he tried to stop you? Ask an adult to help you write down your ideas.</p>	<p>We have read the story of Marvin Gets Mad. Marvin became very angry when his friend Molly had eaten the apple that he wanted. What can we do when we get angry? Ask an adult to help you write down your suggestions.</p>	<p>Create a book of your favourite story. Make sure you include your own illustrations and sentences. If you are feeling creative you can come up with your very own story.</p>
